

5-Year Graduation Rate 2021/22

All Surrey students and the subgroup of English Language Learners were above the provincial graduation rate. Surrey Indigenous Students, Children and Youth in Care, and Students with Designations were below the subgroup provincial graduation rate.




All Surrey Students 5-Year Graduation Rate and Number of Students

Surrey Students graduated at a higher rate in 2021/22 than the two previous years. All Surrey Students graduated at a rate of 89%, higher rate than the provincial rate of 87%.


Surrey Indigenous Students 5-Year Graduation Rate and Number of Students




Indigenous students in Surrey graduated at a higher rate in 2021/22 than the two previous years with an increase of approximately 5% from 2020/21.

Surrey Children and Youth in Care 5-Year Graduation Rate and Number of Students

Graduation rates for Children and Youth in Care in Surrey slightly declined in 2021/22 compared to the previous year. The 2021/22 graduation rate was around 10% below the provincial rate of 40% for students of the same subgroup.




Surrey English Language Learners 5-Year Graduation Rate and Number of Students



English Language Learners in Surrey graduated at a higher rate in 2021/22 than the two previous years. The Graduation rate had around a 5% increase in 2021/22 in comparison to the previous years. Surrey English Language Learners graduated around 3% above the provincial rate of 87% for 2021/22.

Surrey Students with Designations 5-Year Graduation Rate and Number of Students



In 2021/22, Students with Designations graduated at a rate of 66%, an approximate increase of 6% compared to the previous year.

With around 2% lower than the provincial rate, Surrey Students with Designations graduate at a slightly lower percentage than all BC students of the same subgroup.





2021/22 FSA Grade 4 and 7 Percentage and Number of On Track and Extending Students


FSA <u>Grade 4 Reading/Literacy</u> 2021/22




FSA Grade 4 Numeracy 2021/22



FSA Grade 7 Reading/Literacy 2021/22




Feel Welcome – "Do you feel welcome at your school?"

Percentage and Number of Positive Responses (Most/All of the Time)




Adults Who Care - "At your school, how many adults do you feel care about you?"

Percentage and Number of Positive Responses (2 or more adults)




<u>School Belonging – "Is school a place you feel like you belong?"</u>

Surrey Average Class Size 2021/22




