The Evolution of Early Literacy Support

- Early Literacy Teachers (ELT's) in schools for more than two decades
- Number of schools supported has grown from 2 to 26
- Support has shifted over time
- Evidence of impact highlighted in *Enhancing* Student Learning Report

The Current ELT Landscape

- 26 schools
- Targeted early literacy staffing (0.2FTE 1.0FTE)
- Working side-by-side with K and Gr 1 classroom teachers
- Providing in-class, strategic support for learners
- Focusing on oral language development and emergent reading development




