Preamble:

The Surrey Board of Education conducts policy review on an annual basis as an essential part of governance to ensure the effective, efficient and economical delivery of educational and administrative programs and services to students.

Draft revisions and proposals for policies were reviewed by Trustees at an in-service on 2017-04-26 and the public board meeting on 2017-06-08. Subsequent to the 2017-06-08 Board meeting, minor edits have been made to Policy 8700 and Regulation 8100.1. These Policies and Regulations are now being brought to the Board of Education for approval.
