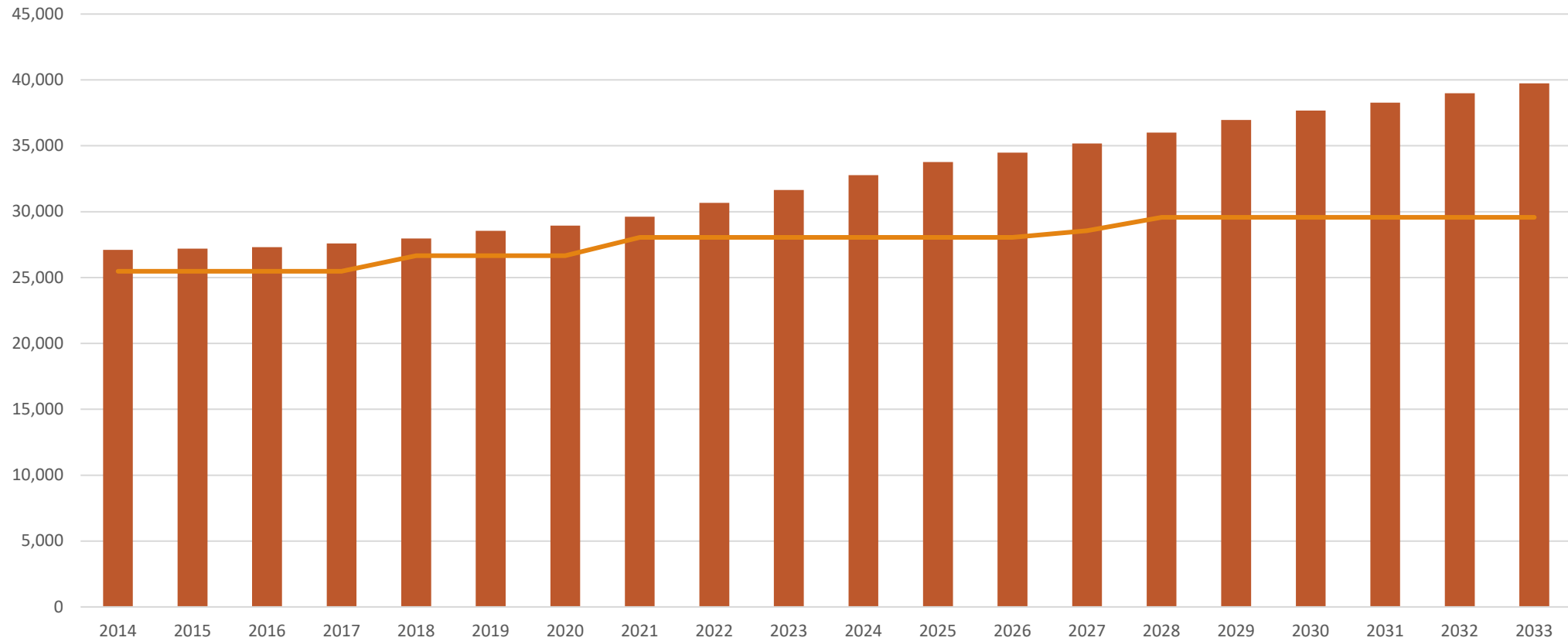

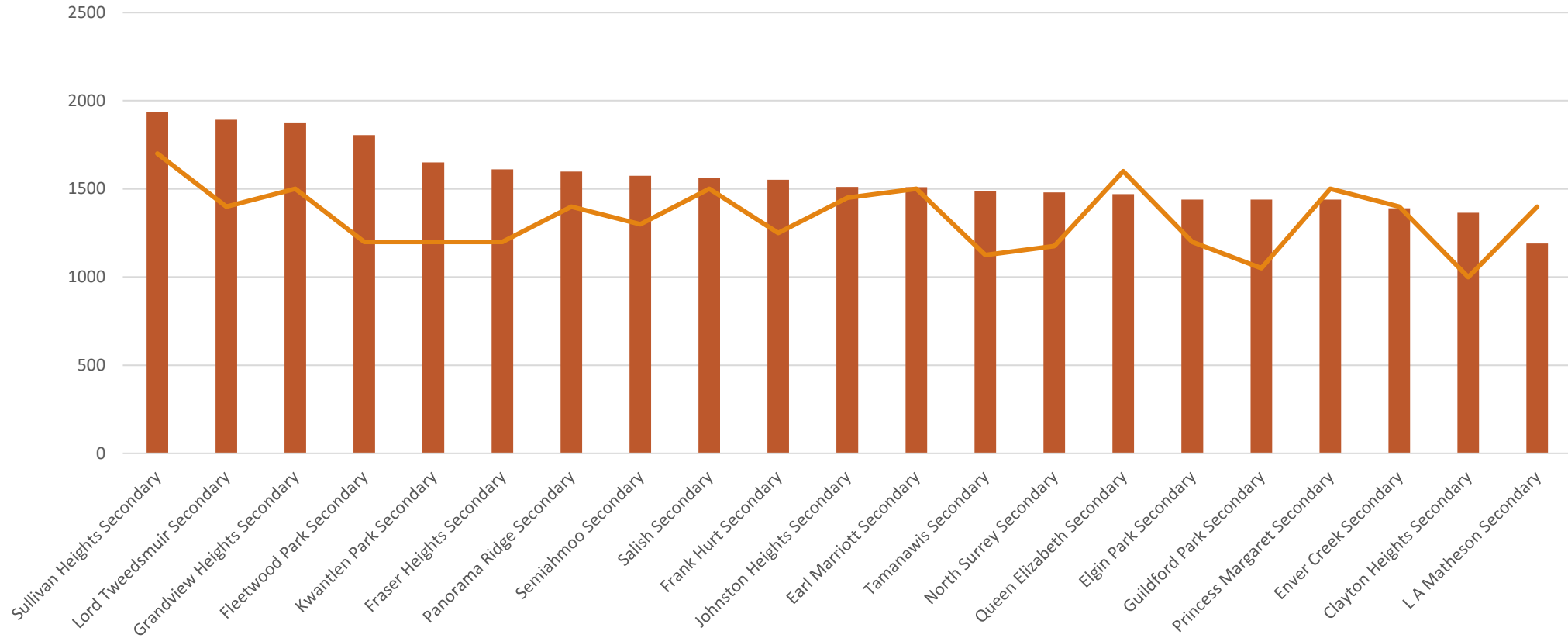

Guiding Principles

1. Provide a high-quality educational experience for all students.
2. Mitigate enrolment capacity challenges at specific schools.
3. Use district facilities more efficiently.



Extended Day Model



- Schools organize with 5 periods per day
- Students attend 4 of these periods
- Students attend periods 1-4 or 2-5

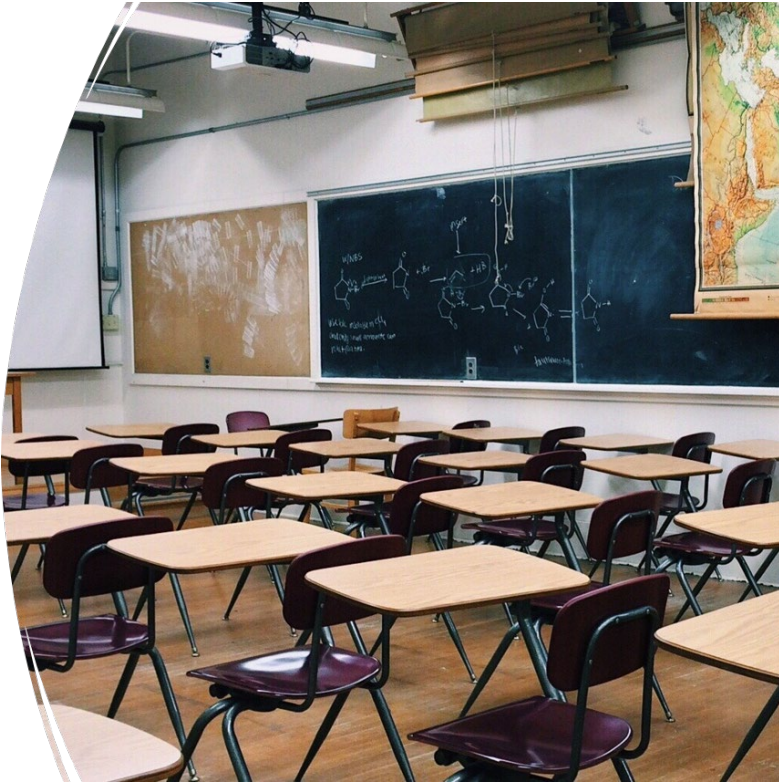


Student Schedule 2-5

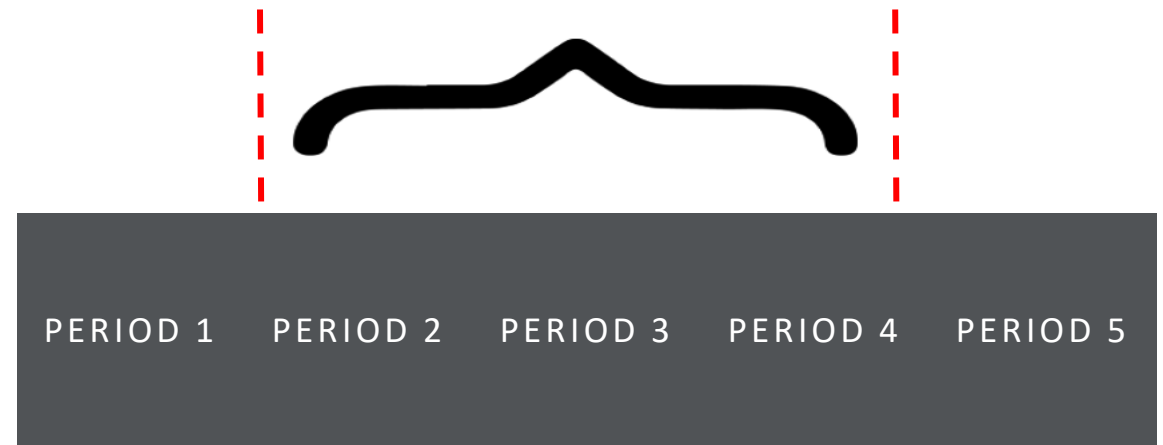

Most students still attend periods 2-4



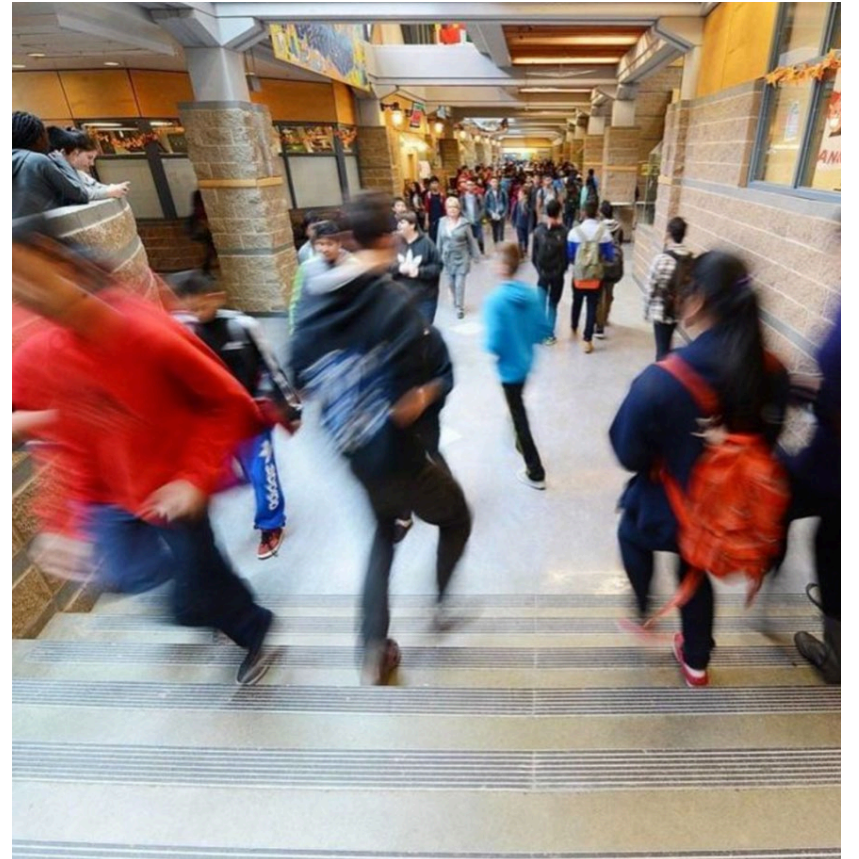
Opportunities - Extended Day

- Increases school capacity by 10-15%
- Allows flexible schedules for some students who may want to start earlier or later in the day
- Allows more access to some specialty areas of the school (theatre, home economics rooms, shop facilities).



Challenges with Extended Day

1. Disruptive for families and the school community
2. Difficult for students who are relied upon on to pick up, drop off, and take care of younger siblings, or who work.
3. Difficult to coordinate extra-curricular activities (athletics, clubs, fine arts).
4. Difficult for staff to coordinate department meetings, school-based team, staff committee, and department head meetings.
5. Unanticipated extra-costs



Extended Day Costs

- Library Staffing
- Youth and Childcare Staffing
- Campus Supervision Staffing
- IESW Staffing
- Bussing Costs
- Staffing Costs: \$65,000
- Bussing Costs: \$280,000





Next Steps

- District staff is finalizing an analysis of which secondary schools will need to be on extended day for September 2024 due to being over capacity.
- It is anticipated that up to 1/3 of the secondary schools will need to be on extended day.
- As per the collective agreement, staff will be providing notice to the Surrey Teacher's Association, and then informing school staffs.
- Notice will occur within the next 2 weeks for this September.
