Meetings

The past few weeks have been busy, with many meetings and events scheduled for trustee participation and advocacy. Trustee representatives came together for various BCSTA meetings including the Metro, Board Chairs', and Board of Directors meetings.

On January 31st, the board met with our local MLAs and representatives from a number of ministry divisions to discuss various topics including the projected growth in Surrey and the capital requirements for our district.

On February 7th, we attended the Partner Liaison Meeting hosted by the BCSTA and Ministry of Education and Child Care. Topics included Safe and Inclusive Schools, Artificial Intelligence, Board Governance, the Implementation of Bill 40, and Supporting Student Success.

Trustees also represented the Board on committee meetings internally at the DPAC General Meeting and Student Voice, and externally on the Surrey Parks Rec and Culture Committee.
