Capital Project Office Update:

The Surrey Executive Project Board meeting was held on Monday, November 6, 2017. The following points were discussed:

1. Surrey School District Cost Contribution to capital projects.

2. Personnel

- Two project managers have been hired; Maryann Mason started November 06, 2017 and Sheetal Basra will start on December 04, 2017.
- Interviews are in progress for the Capital Finance Manger, target award is November 10, 2017.
- Office space will be reconfigured during Christmas break to accommodate new staff.

3. Strategic Real Estate Planning

An RFQ will close November 06, 2017 for a Strategic Real Estate consultant to provide
comprehensive site selection services based on the strategic goals of the district. This would include
identifying appropriate sites, evaluating those sites, determining the full fiscal needs of the
acquisitions, and on through to the acquisitions of the properties.

4. Surrey School District #36 - Fall 2017 Market Sounding

• With the assistance of Partnership BC, Surrey School District #36 (Surrey) conducted a Construction Market Sounding between September 20 and October 19, 2017.

Key tendering recommendations:

- Prequalify general contractors.
- Bundle projects with consideration to proximity of projects, common consultants and timing in determining grouping of tender packages.
- Use the Construction Management procurement model where applicable during this busy market period.
- Identify a pilot project for an Integrated Project Delivery model.
- Allow 30 days between School District tender calls where possible.
- Share our proposed tender schedule with the construction industry in advance.
- Monitor the region's tender activity through regular market soundings, monitoring BC Bid,
 Permit applications and trade journals.
- Do not push projects to tender before they are ready.
- Tender seismic projects as early as possible in 2018.

5. Site 164 Sullivan Secondary School Addition

- SD36 has completed preliminary site planning options for Sullivan Heights Secondary School located at 6248-144 Street, Surrey, BC. Planning options are based on a 700 capacity addition for a total capacity of 1,700 students. The site is heavily constrained by the location of existing buildings, significant site slopes and requirements for parking.
- A PDR will be developed that uses structured parking to accommodate the addition on site and will be compared with an option to find a new site for a new school.

6. Fleetwood Projects

- The Fleetwood area elementary schools additions include the following sites:
 - o #057 William Watson
 - o #160 Frost Road
 - o #157 Coyote Creek
- A PDR for #057 William Watson has been developed for an eleven classroom addition. However due to the fact that this 1958 facility is close to its end of useful life, the PDR will be expanded to include a total replacement option on the same site.
- A four classroom addition is proposed for #157 Coyote Creek to maximize capacity in the Fleetwood area.
- A six classroom addition is proposed for #160 Frost Road to maximize capacity in the Fleetwood area.
