Preamble:

Board Authorized Courses are offered by the School Board to meet student needs and interests. They are authorized by the Board according to requirements set by the Ministry of Education. There is no limit to the number of Board Authorized Courses that may be used as part of the 28 credits of electives students need to fulfill the graduation requirements for the Graduation Program. 1. Athletic Coaching 12

This course has been designed to help students learn the basic skills in order to become a successful coach. In addition, students will receive recognized community certifications that will assist them in obtaining volunteer or paid coaching/leadership positions in the community.
