BYLAW #284, RE: MADDAUGH ROAD ELEMENTARY (SITE 184) DEDICATION – BIODIVERSITY CONSERVATION STRATEGY (BCS) CORRIDOR

THAT the Board dedicate land to the City of Surrey for BCS Corridor at Maddaugh Road Elementary (Site 184), located at 19405 – 76 Avenue, legally described as Lot 1 Block 3 Section 22 Township 8 New Westminster District Plan EPP75056.

The dedication of 4,320 m² (0.432 ha), in favour of the City of Surrey, is required to proceed with the development of Maddaugh Road Elementary. The BCS Corridor is part of the City of Surrey Green Infrastructure Network and Biodiversity Conservation Strategy, to support biodiversity by preserving a variety of habitats that support a range of native species of plants, wildlife and other organisms, and

THAT the Board's signing officers execute documents as required to dedicate land for the BCS Corridor, without compensation, as shown on the attached sketch (in yellow).

The land dedication will have no adverse effect on the use of the remainder of the site by the school district; or our ability to dispose of the remaining site in the future.
