

# SOLUTION: A ONE-STOP SHOP FOR PROGRAMS

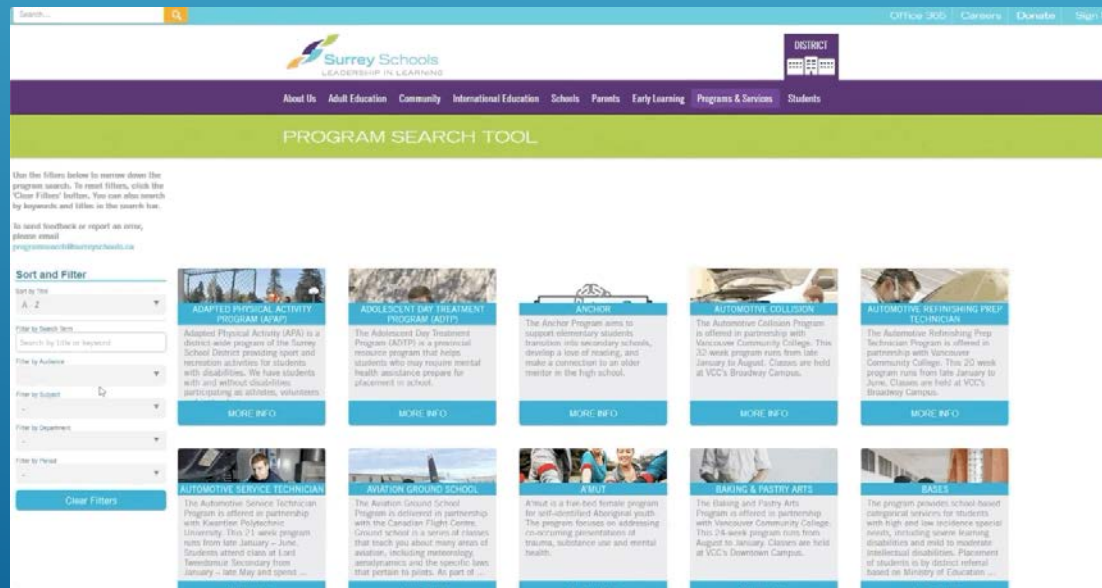

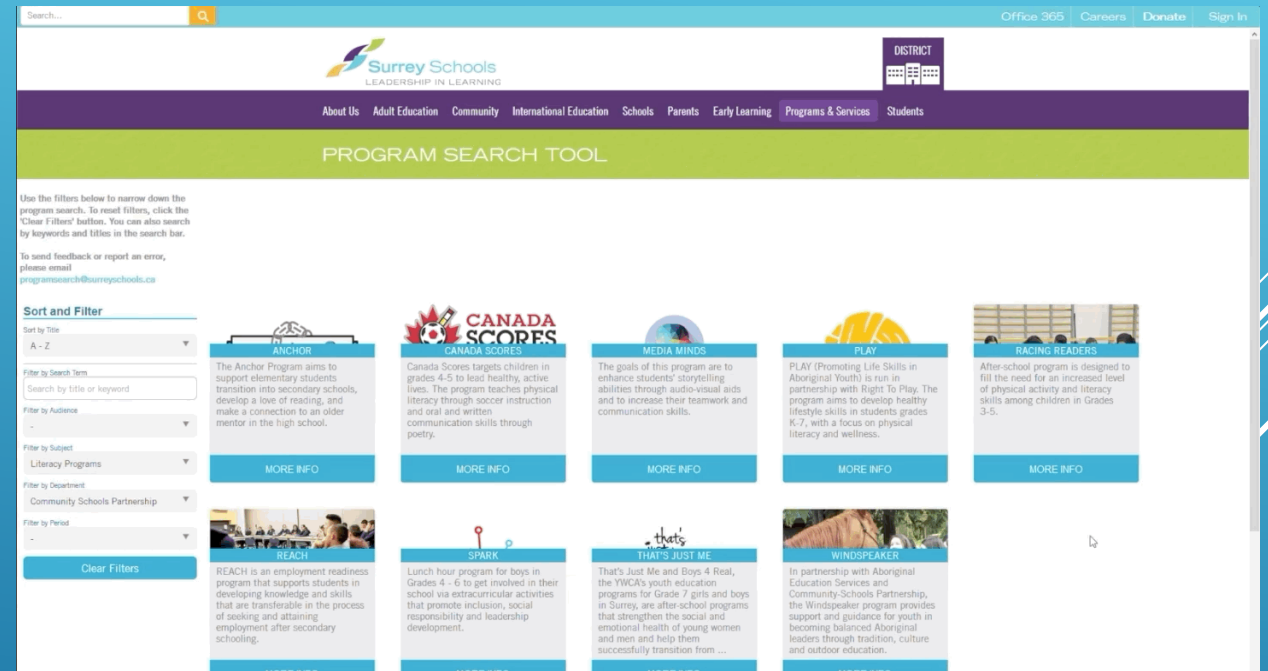
# INTRODUCING: THE PROGRAM SEARCH TOOL

- Filter search enables users to narrow down based on audience, activity type, time held, subject and department



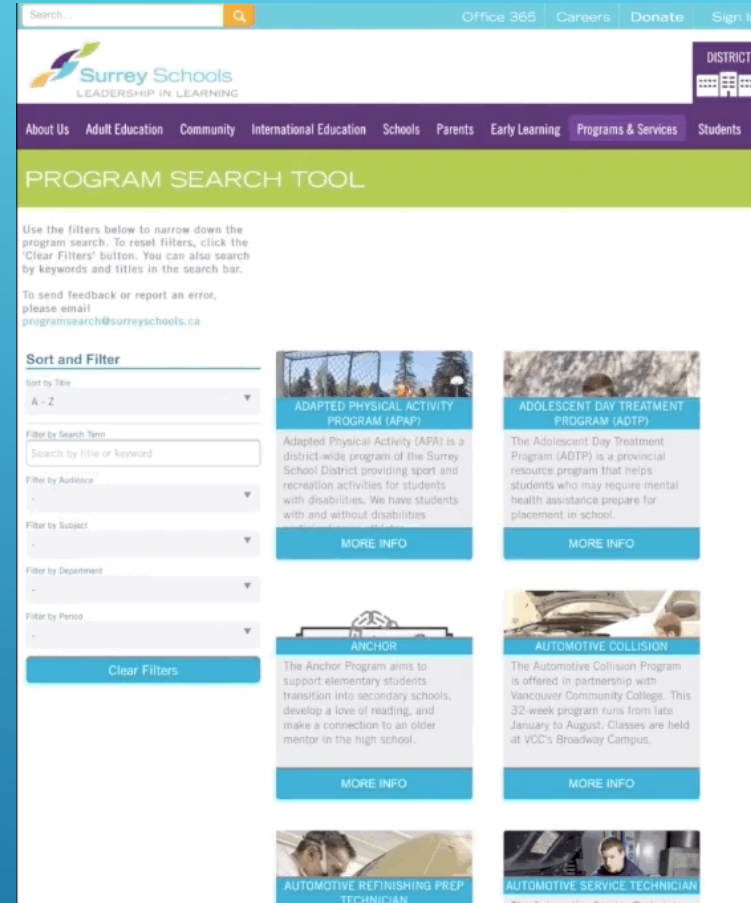
# INDIVIDUAL SUMMARY PAGES


