South Surrey-White Rock Update

Setting the Stage: South Surrey-White Rock

What did we need to do?

- 1. Turn 6 schools into 9 schools with 3 new openings. Which students will attend these 3 new schools?
- 2. Examined and manage the significant overcrowding at Sunnyside Elementary.
- 3. Examined existing boundaries that could be realigned to balance enrolment in existing neighbourhoods to reduce the impact of future growth.




South Surrey- White Rock

The boundary decisions brought to the Board in February 2020 have changed the catchments of East Kensington Elementary, Hall's Prairie Elementary, Morgan Elementary, Pacific Heights Elementary, Rosemary Heights Elementary and Sunnyside Elementary catchments.

New catchment boundaries have also been established for Douglas Elementary and Edgewood Elementary.

Douglas Elementary Update

A new catchment has been established for Douglas Elementary effective November 1, 2020.

Existing Hall's Prairie Elementary students will move to Douglas Elementary on November 9, 2020.

Students who currently attend Hall's Prairie Elementary who are out-of-catchment were given the option of continuing to Douglas Elementary or returning to their neighbourhood catchment schools.

The Montessori program, currently at Sunnyside Elementary, will move to Douglas Elementary on November 2, 2020.

Students who currently attend Sunnyside Montessori who were out-of-catchment for Sunnyside were given the option of moving to the Douglas Montessori program or return to their neighbourhood catchment schools.

Hall's Prairie Site Update

The school site will be available for educational programming effective mid November.

Refined options will be brought back to the Board for discussion.



East Kensington – EKOLogy Program Update

East Kensington site will continue to host the EKOLogy program.

Currently the program consists of students K - 5.

The existing East Kensington catchment will be redistributed to their new catchment schools as shown on the map effective November 1, 2020.



Edgewood Elementary Update

A new catchment boundary has been established for Edgewood Elementary.

All students currently in the Pacific Heights Elementary and Sunnyside Elementary catchments that are captured in Edgewood's new catchment will report to their new school, upon opening, in January 2021.

This will be an immediate move for all students K – 6 and classes have already been established and staffed at Pacific Heights Elementary and Sunnyside Elementary sites.

Transition work will continue to support the new school opening.

Realignment of Existing Boundaries for Morgan Elementary, Sunnyside Elementary and Rosemary Heights Elementary

Phased Move

A phased transition in the north end of the region and will impact all new students residing in these areas, effective January 2021. Sibling rule and grandfathering will apply.


What did we need to do?

2. Determine how to deal with substantial overcrowding at Katzie Elementary and Hazelgrove Elementary.

3. Determine new catchment boundaries for the entire area.

4. Determine the potential educational programming for Clayton Elementary.



Clayton Consultation


Boundary changes will impact Clayton Elementary, Hazelgrove Elementary and Katzie Elementary.

New boundaries have been established for Maddaugh Elementary and Regent Road Elementary.

Maddaugh Update

The Maddaugh Elementary opening has been delayed slightly to March 2021.

Currently, Maddaugh Elementary students have been organized into their Maddaugh classes at Katzie Elementary and Hazelgrove Elementary.

When it is time to move to Maddaugh Elementary, students who reside in Maddaugh Elementary's catchment will transition to Maddaugh Elementary with their classes and teachers.



Grade 7 Students

Grade 7 students will not transition to Maddaugh Elementary during the 2020-2021 school year. These students will complete their Grade 7 year at Katzie Elementary or Hazelgrove Elementary before moving to secondary school. Siblings of these Grade 7 students can choose to move to their new catchment school when it opens, or remain at Katzie Elementary or Hazelgrove Elementary until June 2021, and then move to their new catchment school.

Regent Road Update

Regent Road Elementary is anticipated to open in September 2022.

Due to the close proximity to Clayton Secondary, there will be a phased catchment boundary adjustment for the area between 188th and 189th Street, and between 70th and 72nd Avenue. Students new to this area will attend Regent Road Elementary when it opens, while existing students will continue to attend Hazelgrove Elementary.

Any new students moving into this area will be required to attend Regent Road Elementary, unless they are siblings of students at Hazelgrove Elementary.



Clayton Elementary

When Regent Road Elementary opens, Clayton Elementary will become a K-3 Annex, connected to Regent Road Elementary.

Students who live in the new Regent Road Elementary/Clayton Elementary catchment can choose to attend either Clayton Elementary or Regent Road Elementary for Grades K-3, and will attend Regent Road Elementary for Grades 4-7.
