

Board Report March 10, 2021

I am pleased to report on the work of the Board since our last update.

Advocacy and Liaison

Over the past few weeks, Trustees have represented the Board and district at BCSTA Provincial Council, Metro and Committee meetings, and various district and stakeholder committees and meetings.

On February 24th, the Board met with members of the STA executive for our annual liaison meeting. Not surprisingly, the impact of COVID-19 in our schools and on teachers was forefront on the agenda. There has been much collaboration over the past months, and the meeting provided an opportunity to share experiences, challenges and successes despite the pandemic. Together the Board, district and school teams are continuing to plan with health, safety and well-being of staff and students top of mind.

Last week on March 3rd, the Board met with Surrey MPs and discussed the impact of the pandemic on district budgets, immigration and enrolment; and emphasized the need for continued federal funding to support programs and services.

Earlier this evening, trustees and executive had a productive meeting with the Mayor of White Rock, City Councillors and administration. Topics related to budget, COVID, and those specific to the South Surrey/White Rock areas.
